HOMAK PENN OHIO PRO STOCK CHAMPIONSHIP TOURING SERIES EVENT 2 AT PPMS FINDS CHRIS SCHNEIDER IN VICTORY LANE!



August 6, 2016 (Sandy Lake, PA) The Homak Penn Ohio Pro Stock Championship Touring Series visited PPMS for a second time in the 2016 Season on Saturday, August 6th. Two-time Penn Ohio point champion, Chris Schneider, battled his way from the sixth starting position to victory lane for the \$1,000 paycheck. The win was Schneider's first visit to victory lane in the touring series in the 2016 season; as he had a fourth place finish at Thunder Mountain; a second place at PPMS for the Ed Laboon Memorial Race; and a second place at Dog Hollow Speedway.

The 20-lap A Main stock feature started with a caution flag flying before the completion of lap one for third-starter, Randy Wyant getting sideways in turn two and collecting ninth-starter and 2016 PPMS Ed Laboon winner, Todd Weldon. Once racing got underway, pole-sitter Bobby Whitling pulled away from Rob Shook and the rest of the field; while fifth starting Brent Johnson moved pass Shook for second. On lap three, Whitling was cruising to a comfortable lead when Schneider and Daryl Chalier went around Johnson for second and third. Schneider was closing in on Whitling and made the passing move for the lead on the backstretch on lap 6. Chalier then had the outside momentum to move Whitling back to the third spot one lap later. Lap traffic had Schneider slowed on the back stretch and Chalier took advantage of the situation, passing Schneider and leading laps 8 through 14. On lap 14, a caution would slow racing action only after Chalier had a 5 second lead over

Schneider. A single file restart had Schneider battling Charlier going into 1 and 2 but Charlier used the outside to hold onto the lead until a caution would fly on lap 17. Under yellow, sparks were visible under Charlier's car and when the green flag flew, it was evident that mechanical woes would slow Charlier from holding off Schneider. Charlier dropped back to fourth spot, while Schneider cruised his way to victory lane over the 28 car field. Whitling finished in second over Jake Simmons for third. Charlier held onto the fourth spot over Bill Robertson. Rounding out the top ten were Wayne Carbo in sixth, Joel Johns in seventh, Brent Johnson in eighth, AJ Poljak in ninth, and Ricky Steigerwald in tenth.

Heat race winners were Johns, Schneider, Charlier, and Carbo. The hard luck award donated by Shaffer's Auto Service went to Jesse Brock as he was involved in a mishap under yellow prior to the A Main starting. The Hard Charger donated by Hickory Bar and Grille went to 28th starter, Brian Rhed, as he gained 12 positions finishing 16th.
