ROB SHOOK WINS \$2,550 HOMAK MANUFACTURING 30 AT THUNDER MOUNTAIN!



Rob Shook made an impressive appearance at Thunder Mountain Speedway Friday night for the Homak Penn Ohio Pro Stock Series Homak Manufacturing 30. Shook made his way from the fifth starting position to take the lead on lap 6 and continued to lead the pack the rest of the way. Not only did Rob take the \$2,500 pay check home, he starts the 2016 Penn Ohio Touring Series season as the point leader.

A great turnout of 41 pro stocks made exciting races for the fans. The evening started off with qualifying. Chris Schneider had fastest qualifying with a 17.793 time followed by Tim Bish's 17.924 and Gary Luzier's 18.041. Six heat races certainly kept the crowd entertained with three cars qualifying for the A Main. Heat race winners were Brian Rhed, Gary Luzier, Ryan Newman, Chris Schneider, Fuzzy Fields, and Brent Johnson. Two B Main races set the rest of the field for the A Main with three cars qualifying from each. B Main winners were Nate Smith and Rusty Moore.

The top 12 cars from the heat races then competed for the \$500 dash for cash sponsored by Coleman Well Services LLC. A redraw determined starting positions for the dash and finishing order set starting positions for the A Main. An exciting 8 lap race had second starter, Gary Luzier, finishing in the top spot taking home the \$500 and pole position for the A Main. Top five finishers in the dash were Newman in second over Rusty Martz, Fuzzy Fields, and Rob Shook.

The 30 lap A Main event had 26 stocks competing for the \$2,550 prize. Door-to-door racing action occurred from the front of the pack to the back. Dash Winner, Gary Luzier, led four laps with Rusty Martz, Rob Shook and Brent Johnson battling for the second through fourth positions. Caution flag flew after the completion of lap four when Steven Arthurs slowed in turn four. Action resumed with Luzier leading Shook, Martz, Johnson, Ryan Newman, and Fuzzy Fields. The battle would continue throughout the pack with caution flags flying on lap 13, 16, and 23.

Brian Rhed made his presence known taking the second spot from Johnson on lap 14 but didn't have enough to take the top spot from Shook. Johnson maintained third position with Chris Schneider finding his way to fourth and Rusty Martz rounding out the top five. Sixth spot went to 18th starter, Nate Smith. Rod Laskey came from 20th spot and finished 7th taking home the \$100 Hard Charger Award from Animal Graphics. Rounding out the top ten were Rusty Moore, Bill Hurrelbrink, and Bob Schwartzmiller.
