**MAKE UP RACE AT TRI CITY RACEWAY PARK PROVED TO BE WORTH THE WAIT – SCHNEIDER ENDS THE NIGHT IN VICTORY LANE AND PICKS UP THE \$1,200 PAY DAY!**

September 12, 2016 (Sandy Lake, PA) Tri City Raceway Park hosted the Homak Penn Ohio Pro Stock Championship Touring Series on Sunday, September 11<sup>th</sup> for the rescheduled August 14<sup>th</sup> event. The \$500 to-win and \$700 touring series bonus found 29 stock car drivers ready for action. Chris Schneider, current Homak Penn Ohio Pro Stock Championship Touring Series point leader, was able to continue his winning streak to four-in-a-row with the Series capturing the lead on lap 2 from Brian Rhed, and despite numerous cautions brought home the \$1,200 victory.

Starting the main event on the front row were touring series' members, Brian Rhed and Ryan Newman. Brian Rhed was able to pull ahead of Newman on the start and lead the first lap; however, third-starter Chris Schneider made his presence known quickly by taking the lead over on lap 2. An early caution bunched the field up and gave Rhed an opportunity to battle Schneider for the lead. Randy Wyant restarted third with Newman in fourth. Several attempts

were made to get racing action going, but driver mishaps had the caution flag flying three times before drivers settled in and the racing action resumed.

Schneider jumped out to the lead with Wyant taking over the second spot from Rhed. Rhed slipped back to fourth on lap 5 as Rod Laskey charged from the seventh starting spot for third. On lap 7 local favorite and ninth-starter, Bobby Whitling took over the fourth spot from Rhed. The top five running order remained with Schneider leading the pack through lap traffic until the caution flag flew on lap 18 for sixth place runner, Andy Buckley and lapped car, Jesse Brock. The single file restart gave Wyant a chance to knock Schneider out of contention for his four-in-a-row win with the Penn Ohio Series but Schneider was too smooth and drove his SS Chassis & Supply/Nick Chevrolet/It's All Clean-sponsored #55 to victory lane.

Wyant held on for the second spot over Laskey, while Whitling finished in fourth over Rhed. Rob Shook started the race in sixth and finished in sixth. Eleventh starter, Todd Weldon, came home in seventh. Rounding out the top ten were Ryan Newman, Pat Fielding, and William Hurrelbrink. Fuzzy Fields made his way from 26<sup>th</sup> to the 12<sup>th</sup> finishing spot to earn the 7W/Seneca Slider Hard Charger sponsored award. Heat winners over the 29-car field were Shook, Wyant, and Schneider.
